Reading: John 6:1-40

Things to Look For: Jesus feeds 5,000, walks on the water, and identifies Himself as the bread of life.

Further Reading: Exodus 16, Psalm 78

☐ Day 8

Reading: John 6:41-71

Things to Look For: Jesus explains how He is the bread of life.

Further Reading: Isaiah 54

☐ Day 9

Reading: John 7

Things to Look For: Jesus teaches in Jerusalem. The Pharisees dispute with Him. There is debate on whether Jesus is the Messiah.

Further Reading: Micah 5, Isaiah 9

☐ Day 10

Reading: John 8:1-30

Things to Look For: The Pharisees confront Jesus with a woman caught in adultery. Jesus identifies Himself as the light of the world. The Pharisees debate Jesus concerning His identity.

Further Reading: Leviticus 20:10, Deuteronomy 22:22, Isaiah 60

☐ Day 11

Reading: John 8:31-59

Things to Look For: Jesus identifies Himself as the Son of God. Jesus uses the phrase “I AM”, the name God used with Moses in Exodus.

Further Reading: Exodus 3

☐ Day 12

Reading: John 9

Things to Look For: Jesus heals a blind man. The Pharisees confront the blind man about the healing.

Further Reading: Isaiah 35

☐ Day 13

Reading: John 10

Things to Look For: Jesus identifies Himself as the Good Shepherd. The religious leaders confront Jesus about His identity, and seek to kill Him.

Further Reading: Psalm 23

☐ Day 14

Reading: John 11:1-27

Things to Look For: Lazarus dies, Jesus travels to Judaea to raise him from the dead.

Further Reading: 1 Corinthians 15

☐ Day 15

Reading: John 11:28-57

Things to Look For: Jesus raises Lazarus from the dead. The Pharisees plot to kill Jesus.

Further Reading: Hebrews 4

☐ Day 16

Reading: John 12

Things to Look For: Mary anoints Jesus with costly ointment. Jesus enters Jerusalem with the multitude celebrating Him. Jesus prophesies of His death. Some believe in Jesus, but others do not believe.

Further Reading: Zechariah 9:9, Isaiah 53

☐ Day 17

Reading: John 13

Things to Look For: Jesus eats the Last Supper with His disciples and washes their feet.

Jesus prophesies of His betrayal by Judas and His denial by Peter.

Further Reading: Psalm 41

☐ Day 18

Reading: John 14

Things to Look For: Jesus prophesies of His death. Jesus promises to prepare a place for His people, and He will send the Holy Spirit to comfort and guide them.

Further Reading: Isaiah 26

☐ Day 19

Reading: John 15

Things to Look For: Jesus is the vine and His followers are the branches. Jesus offers true joy. Jesus commands His disciples to love one another.

Further Reading: Psalm 69

☐ Day 20

Reading: John 16

Things to Look For: Jesus warns of persecution and sorrow, but ultimately joy and victory. The Holy Spirit will guide His disciples into all truth.

Further Reading: Acts 2

☐ Day 21

Reading: John 17

Things to Look For: Jesus prays for God to receive glory, for His disciples, and for all future believers.

Further Reading: Philippians 2

☐ Day 22

Reading: John 18

Things to Look For: Jesus is betrayed by Judas. Peter denies Jesus. Jesus is placed on trial.

Further Reading: 1 Peter 2:21-25

☐ Day 23

Reading: John 19

Things to Look For: Jesus is beaten, crucified, and placed in the tomb.

Further Reading: Psalm 22, Zechariah 12:10

☐ Day 24

Reading: John 20

Things to Look For: Mary Magdalene discovers the empty tomb. Jesus appears to His disciples. Thomas doubts until He sees Jesus.

Further Reading: Matthew 28, Mark 16, Luke 24



☐ Day 25

Reading: John 21

Things to Look For: Jesus appears to His disciples. Jesus instructs Peter to love and lead His followers as a shepherd who loves and feeds his sheep.

Further Reading: Ezekiel 34

☐ Day 26

Reading: 1 John 1

Things to Look For: Jesus is the Word made flesh. Jesus is the light and has no darkness.

Further Reading: Proverbs 8:22-30, Revelation 21

☐ Day 27

Reading: 1 John 2

Things to Look For: Believers should not sin, but should confess their sins. Believers should keep His commandments, love one another. Believers should not love the world, and should beware of false teachers.

Further Reading: Psalm 103

☐ Day 28

Reading: 1 John 3

Things to Look For: Those who believe on Jesus are brought into the family of God. We are to love one another and keep His commandments.

Further Reading: Genesis 4

☐ Day 29

Reading: 1 John 4

Things to Look For: Believers should beware false teachers and should love one another.

Further Reading: Deuteronomy 6:4-5, 13:1-5, Leviticus 19:18

☐ Day 30

Reading: 1 John 5

Things to Look For: Believers must have faith in Jesus Christ to overcome the world. Believers can be confident in the knowledge that they have eternal life.

Further Reading: Romans 8

“Open thou mine eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of thy law.” Psalm 119:18

My First 30 Days in God’s Word

This plan is designed to help you develop a habit of daily Bible study. It is important to set aside time each day to study God’s Word, allowing Him to speak to you and providing you the opportunity to learn more about Him and His plan for your life.

Each day includes a *passage* of Scripture to read, a *summary* of things to look for during your time study, and *other Scriptures* that you can examine to learn more about the passage and to help you see how the entire Bible, both the Old Testament and the New Testament, teach the same truths and point to the same Savior of the world: Jesus Christ!

Ask your pastor or a faithful member of your church family to join you, then let each other know at least one truth that God is teaching you.

☐ Day 1

Reading: John 1

Things to Look For: Jesus is the Creator God. Jesus is the Word made flesh. John the Baptist points others to Jesus. Jesus calls His first disciples.

Further Reading: Genesis 1, Colossians 1

☐ Day 2

Reading: John 2

Things to Look For: Jesus performs His first miracle. Jesus expels the money changers from the temple. Jesus prophesies of His resurrection.

Further Reading: Psalm 66

☐ Day 3

Reading: John 3

Things to Look For: Jesus is visited by Nicodemus. Jesus explains salvation to him. John the Baptist points to Jesus as the Savior.

Further Reading: Numbers 21:4-9, Deuteronomy 18:18

☐ Day 4

Reading: John 4:1-30

Things to Look For: Jesus shares the gospel with the woman at the well in Samaria.

Further Reading: Genesis 33, Isaiah 12

☐ Day 5

Reading: John 4:31-54

Things to Look For: Jesus explains His work to the disciples, saves others in Samaria, and heals a nobleman’s son.

Further Reading: Job 23:12, Psalm 63:5, Psalm 119:103, Jeremiah 15:16

☐ Day 6

Reading: John 5

Things to Look For: Jesus heals a man on the Sabbath. The Pharisees are offended at His work. Jesus identifies Himself as God’s Son.

Further Reading: Isaiah 40, Jeremiah 17
